- Delaying Early Marriage in Niger – partnership with UNFPA to reduce early marriage and early pregnancy in critical mass of communities in Niger
- Voices Against Violence – partnership with UN Women to prevent and reduce gender discrimination and violence against women and girls through non-formal education and youth engagement and leadership

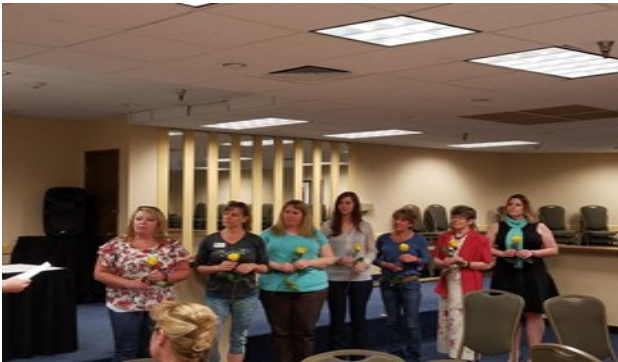

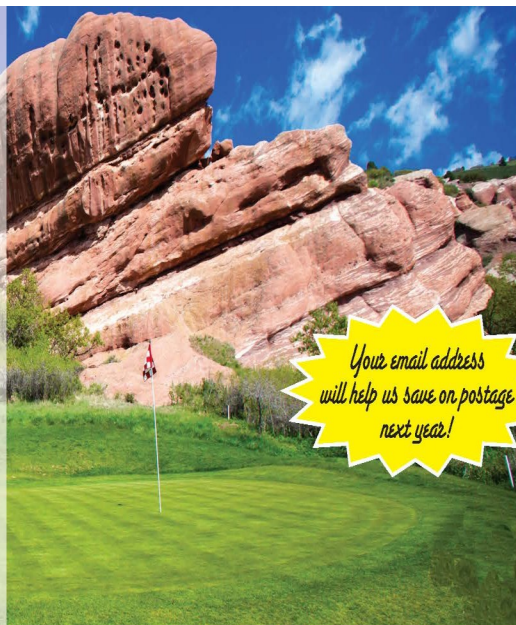

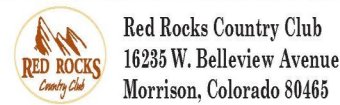

## Founder of Zonta



**Marion de Forest**

**Spirit Of Womanhood Statue in New York  
Founder of Zonta**

Visionary Marian de Forest overcame childhood hardship to become a respected journalist and playwright, and major force in the progressive women's movement.

Upon graduating from Buffalo Seminary, de Forest became one of the first female reporters in Western New York State and quickly rose to become a drama critic and department editor. In 1919, in Buffalo, NY, she founded Zonta (later Zonta International), a service organization of executives and professionals dedicated to improving the legal, political, economic, educational, health and professional status of women. Zonta International has more than 33,000 members in 65 countries worldwide.

De Forest was also a strong proponent of the arts. As a leading playwright, she supported women's role in the theater and received numerous accolades, including induction into The Lyceum of London. De Forest's love of music led her to co-found the Buffalo Musical Foundation, bring the American Opera Company to Western New York, and play a prominent role in the formation of the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra.
