Happy October, Zontians!



LCCC Scholarship

It was more than 25-30 years ago that Zonta Club of Cheyenne started the Mary Read Rogers scholarship at Laramie County Community College (LCCC) for non-traditional students. Mary Read Rogers was a very active, outspoken Zontian for many years, having established her credentials as a presswoman and civic leader in Cheyenne.

With the assistance of the Wyoming State Legislature's challenge grant program which began in 2004 the LCCC Foundation has been able to match our \$10,000 investment, money raised from our traditional Antique Show. The interest earned from this endowment fund has been awarded as scholarships since 2006.

LCCC announces the scholarship availability, receives the applications, and forwards them to Zonta Club of Cheyenne. This year there were 11 candidates for our scholarship. The committee decided to award the top two applicants \$600 each, enough for each to cover 4 college credit hours. The recipients are *Aimee Raya* and *Jessica Werner*.


