Five years ago, Grace United Methodist women held a

Rally for Women's Rights and the Elimination of Violence and Abuse against Women and Children

for International Women's Day, March 8th on the Capitol steps.



Members of other churches, Zonta Club of Cheyenne, Peak Wellness Center, Triumph's Z Club, other women's assistance organizations, and the citizens of Cheyenne were invited to show Wyoming that we are the Equality State, and that *violence and abuse of our women and children (all interpersonal criminal acts) are unacceptable*. It is vital that we provide women and children with a safe environment in which to live, learn, and work, and victims to heal.

Each year, Ty Warner has volunteered his special music and support, as his band lost their lead singer to domestic violence.

We are holding the 6th Annual Rally for Women's Rights on MARCH 7th, at 11:00 on the Wyoming Supreme Court steps. Speakers, including Rep. Affie Ellis, agency representatives, and supporters will **join together** to focus on current issues, recent information, and ways to help show we care about all victims and survivors.

We continue to keep the protection of women and children in the forefront of our focus, and to find more ways to help them as we stand together in support.
