Human trafficking is another space that we will continue to work in. Many organizations have taken up this topic after Zonta brought it to the forefront in our community. We recognize that there is more to be done in regards to human trafficking so we will

continue to educate and participate in activities that support awareness.

Several of us recently had an opportunity to visit the new “Stages” project that COMEA is just starting for low barrier housing. The Stagecoach Motel was recently purchased by the City of Cheyenne and the county and given to COMEA to address individuals who struggled to stay housed at COMEA for a variety of reasons.

COME A is remodeling the hotel into 30 efficiency apartments and will help to house individuals while they provide wrap around services to help them get on their feet and move them on. There is a lot of work to be done and we will be exploring how we might be involved. There are currently three women who are being considered for residency in this new program.
