Message from the President

November was another busy month for our Zonta Club. Sometimes I wonder if what we are doing is making a difference and then something happens to remind me that what we are doing is so important to our community. For me, this month I was reminded

as I participated in the Silent Witness March with family members of two women who were killed as a result of domestic violence.

Hearing their families talk about their family member who was no longer

with them and the aftermath that they face each day was so moving. Listening to our guest speaker, Sally Loya, discuss her 80 hours of captivity with her abuser who left her for dead reinforced that what may seem insignificant has life changing importance to those trapped in abusive relationships.

Phone numbers to national help lines in restrooms, educating people in our community about the signs of an

abusive relationship, and providing a way for families to remember their loved ones who have been lost as a result of domestic violence is s-o-o-o important!

I also had the privilege of dropping off the Hope Bags that the East High National Honor Society helped organize and fill

to the sexual assault nurse. She was so thankful for the bags and that they were marked and ready to go. We had a chance to visit and she shared that these bags show how the community cares for individuals who are feeling so violated and betrayed.

Thank you for all that you do—whether you helped shop for Hope Bags, participated in the Silent Witness March, arranged the proclamation signing, helped set up silhouettes at the library, or helped to hang a poster in local restrooms—you are appreciated!

I hope you will enjoy the holiday season with your friends and family. It will be important that everyone is rested up as we hit January and work towards a successful Cancel Out event in March!

Reauthorization of the Family Violence Prevention and Services Act

There is an urgent need to contact your U.S. Senators in support of the Reauthorization of the Family Violence Prevention and Services Act, S.1275. Please consider asking them to support this bill <u>now</u>. The related bill has been passed by the House of Representatives, so now it is the Senate's turn. If it does not pass before the end of the current 117th Congress, it will be back to square one and the process will need to restart with the new Congress. The spirit of Thanksgiving continues as the necessities we collected for our Zontian friend, Lubya Maksymovych, who runs the Center for Women's Perspectives and more importantly the refugee shelters for women and children in Lviv, Ukraine have been delivered!!!!!

I am so relieved, happy, and thankful for your help. We did it! We have been supported throughout the last 3 months by two relief agencies, Historia Vita, and Via Vitae who worked so hard to get the packages released by the Polish customs office; another story for another time. The latter organization was created by one of the Historia Vita employees to continue to send smaller parcels to Ukraine because Historia Vita stopped that service while we were waiting for the release of the packages. Her name is Iza, and she took over for the first and worked doggedly to get these packages to Ukraine.

Thank you all who helped with this project for it will touch the hearts of many women who have had to leave their homes with only the clothing on their backs, and no access to feminine hygiene products.

I am thankful for Luba's friendship and that we could offer a glimmer of help.
