Membership Directory Update

It's time for the District 12 Directory to be updated for the 2023-2024 year. The new directory will be posted on zontadistrict12.org in the Members Only Area by September 15, 2023.

This year, the basis for *club member* information will be taken from the ZI Club Member List, not from the current 2022-2023 D12 directory.

The District is asking club members to review/update their directory and profile information in their MyZonta account on the ZI website to insure it is correct since it will be used as the basis for member information this year. The document beginning below, 'Managing Your MyZonta Account', outlines the steps to follow for this process. *Only one phone number will be listed in the D12 directory this year, so if members want their cell phone listed please have them put it in the home phone field as that field will be used in the D12 directory.*

Managing Your My Zonta Account

Zonta International Members, we thank you for your support in managing your account online. We rely on you to help us keep our records up-to-date and accurate.

No matter what you are looking to accomplish, you can do it online. Managing your account online can cut down processing time by days or even weeks.

Please follow the below step-by-step instructions to manage your My Zonta profile:

1. Login: Go to <https://zonta.org/> and click **Sign In** or **My Zonta**.




2. Once prompted, enter your email address as the username and then enter your password.





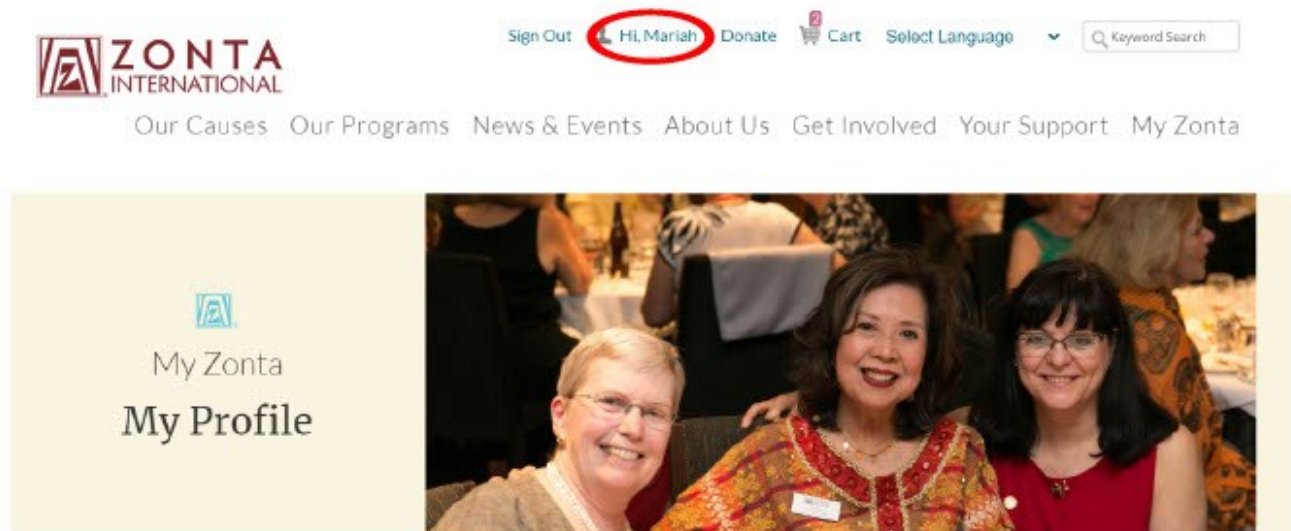
- Once you have clicked the "password" button, a pop-up box will appear requesting your username. Enter your **email address** on file with Zonta as your username. Click **Submit**.

- Enter your chosen new password. It needs to be at least 7 characters long. Once you have clicked submit, it will take you back to the Zonta homepage.

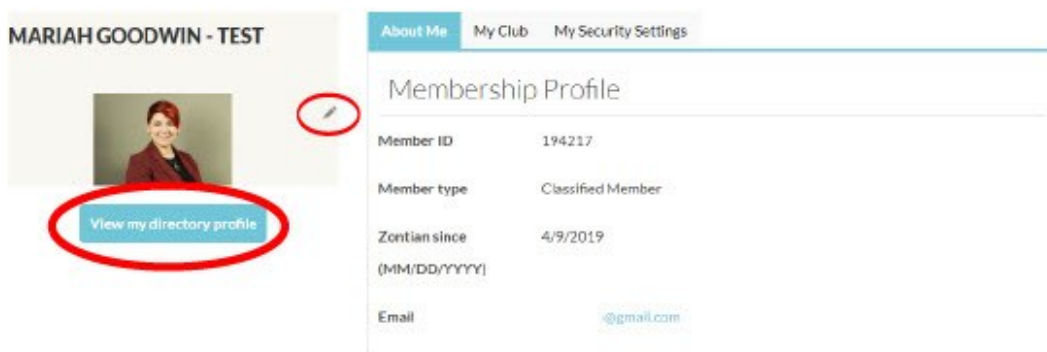
4. From anywhere on the website, once you are logged in, you may click on your name at the top of the page to be redirected to your My Zonta Profile.

7. Scroll down to view your personal details. You may change any of the items in the **My Personal Details** Section.
8. To edit your addresses, click the pencil icon in the upper right corner of the **My Address** section.





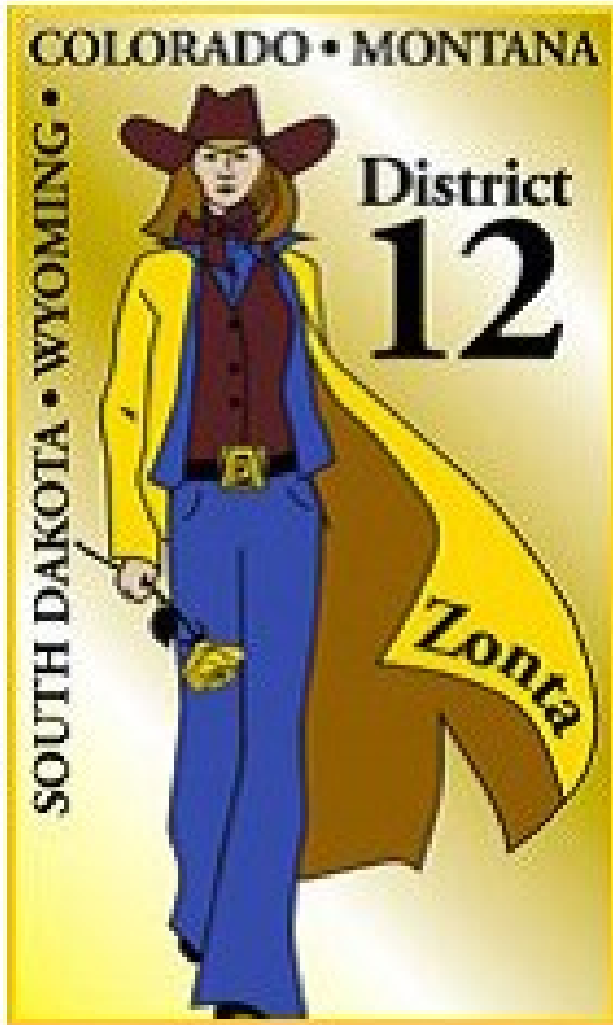
